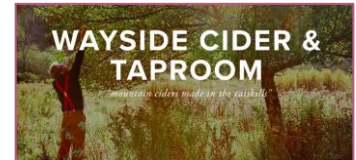




Cornell Hard Cider Program Work Team Catskill Cider Tour August 12th
