***Directions:** **Williams potato field – Decker Rd. just west of Minstead Rd, Marion, 14505 –**
From Rt. 88 in Newark, drive north, crossing the Erie Canal, and then the railroad. Come shortly to the CCE – Wayne Co. Extension building on the left, and Hydesville Rd. Turn left on Hydesville Rd. and a quick right onto Minstead Rd. Go just over 4 miles and turn left onto Decker Rd. The trial is on the muck on the left.

Williams Farms packing house, 5077 Russell Rd, Marion, NY 14505 -
From the Cornell potato variety trial on Decker Rd. drive back to Minstead Rd. and turn left. Continue north on Minstead Rd. ~3.8 mi. to a T. Turn left and follow Beam Hill Rd. over the hill and all the way to Marion-E. Williamson Rd. Turn left onto Marion-E. Williamson Rd. and go south just under ½ mi. to Russell Rd. Turn right onto Russell Rd. and into the parking lot of Williams Farm packing house and storages. Park near the office.
