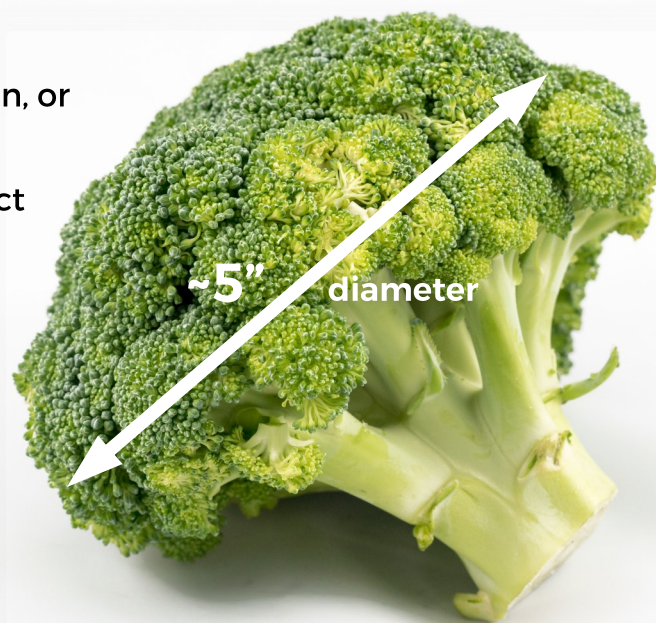


BROCCOLI CROWNS

Grade: U.S. #1

- ✓ Bud clusters should be dark green, sage green, or even green with a purplish tinge
- ✓ Each bud cluster must be a very well compact bunch
- ✓ Stems should be pale green in color and should be tender
- ✓ Standard broccoli box, 20 lbs



AVOID

- ✗ Loose bud clusters or loose crowns



- ✗ Yellowing caused by opening of flower buds



- ✗ Black spots due to disease and rot
