

**CAULIFLOWER 9'S**

Grade: U.S. #1

- ✓ Must have white to creamy white color
- ✓ Clean and firm and uniform in size
- ✓ Compact snow ball type of curd
- ✓ Must have a fresh, green jacket about 1/3 - 1/2 of the way up the head
- ✓ Pack 9 count when head is 8 inches in diameter, not including jacket
- ✓ Pack in standard open faced cauliflower box



**NOTE:** Maximum amount of yellowing due to sunburn allowed during times when sunburn-free cauliflower is unavailable is 20%

**AVOID**

- ✗ Decay
- ✗ Sunburn
- ✗ Signs of riceyness
- ✗ Blemishes
