Trial Information

- All data is from the replications at Wertman Farm and Greenhouses. The Davenport replications were observational only.
- Planted May 30th and windrowed for data collection in the third week of September. They were removed from the field and placed in the greenhouse October 16th.
- Planted on six foot centers with in row spacing varying determined by the seed company.
- Name tag in pictures is eleven inches long for size perspective.

- Planted at 7 foot in row spacing.
- 115 days to harvest
- Average weight: 19.5 lbs
- Dense, heavy pumpkin
- Stems are doughy and dry
- Lovely fruit shape and color with medium ribbing





Bayhorse Gold

- From Rupp Seed Company
- 5 foot in row spacing
- 100 days to harvest
- Average weight: 16.4 lbs
- Very solid, nice fruit
- Fairly good stems, dried down well and well anchored

Bellatrix

- From Siegers Seed
- 95 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 15.2 lbs
- Barrel to tall round shape
- Stems are okay with a little breakage
- Some variability in rib depth and size





Big Loretta

- From Siegers Seed
- 105 days to harvest
- 5.3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 27.6 lbs
- Shape is okay with variable ribbing
- Color is more yellowish
- Mostly bad stems
- Lighter fruit

Bisbee Gold

- From Rupp Seed
 Company
- 90 days to harvest
- Average weight: 4.5 lbs
- Tall round pie
- Stems are marginal with most fraying
- Some size variation
- Good medium to dark orange color





Blanco

- From Seedway
- Spacer variety
- 100 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Held color well

Blaze

- From Seedway
- 100 days to harvest
- 1.5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 2.2 lbs
- Some size variation, ¹/₂ pound to 3 pounds
- Wispy handle, thin and papery, mostly falling apart





Capital

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 95 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 9.3 lbs
- Bad stems, easily broken
- Variation in color and ribbing
- Medium orange color



Cargo

- From Siegers Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight 14.3
- Very few fruit harvested, so actual harvest may be different
- Hard dried stem
- Nice looking pumpkin with medium dark color

Cinnamon Girl

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
- 85 days to harvest
- 2 foot in row spacing
- Spacer variety





Conquest

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 19.1 lbs
- Really nice shape and color
- Excellent stems, rock solid
- Variable shape
- Hefty and dense fruit
- One of the favorite varieties in trial
- Produced a large amount of fruit

Cronus

- From Harris Seeds
- 115 days to harvest
- 7 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 21.4 lbs
- Okay handles, long and fragile
- Beautiful fruit, round and uniform in shape
- Burnt orange to dark orange color





Denali

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 95 days to harvest
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 19.1 lbs
- Huge shape variation
- Yellow to orange color
- Okay stems with some dried down and cracking
- Interesting shapes

Dynasty

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 95 days to harvest
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 17.7 lbs
- Variable stem quality, but not great
- Dense and hefty fruit
- Average shape and color





Early Abundance

- From Harris Seeds
- 90 days to harvest
- 2.5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 4.8 lbs
- Pie type, medium size
- Thick, rock solid stem
- Dark burnt orange color
- Nice shape, very uniform

Edison

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 11.3 lbs
- Variable shape and size
- Some stems are okay, some are bad
- Very dense fruit
- Orangey brown color





Eros

- From Siegers Seed
- 110 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 10.1 lbs
- Terrible stems, frayed
- Nice, dark orange color
- Not very dense
- Nice shape and color

Eureka

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 12.5 lbs
- Uniform shape and size
- Stems aren't good
- Dense, heavy fruit
- Nice ribbing
- A little green background speckling that may be virus





Flame

- From Seedway
- 90 days to harvest
- 1.5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 0.8 lbs
- Munchkin type
- Some variation in shape and color
- Hard stems
- Abundant fruit

Gumdrop

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
- 95 days to harvest
- 2 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 7.5 lbs
- Variable but pleasing shape with nice ribs
- Nice dark orange color
- Thick, hard stems





HMX53L6790

- From Harris Seeds
- 7 foot in row spacing
- Only one fruit harvested from Davenport observational trial

HSC 151

- From Seedway
- 100 days to harvest
- 1.5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 6.9 lbs
- Hulless seeded variety
- Seeds taste excellent when roasted





- Good, hard stems
- Interesting color pattern



Hulk

- From Siegers Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 5.3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 22.8 lbs
- Nice shape and size
- Variable stem quality, some okay, some doughy
- Great carver
- Medium orange color with some background russeting

lgor

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
- 5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 21.5
- Interesting shape and skin texture
- Neat looking
- Dense fruit
- Stems are okay
- Orangey brown color





Jason

- From Siegers Seed
- 100 days to harvest
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 17.1 lbs
- Very uniform size and shape
- Doughy stems
- Medium to dark orange color
- Nice size and shape

JPN 62005R

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 17.4 lbs
- Uniform shape
- Good stems, very solid
- Orangey brown color
- Excellent medium jack





Kratos

- From Seedway/Harris Seeds
- 100 days to harvest
- 7 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 18.1 lbs
- Excellent barrel shape
- Dark orange color
- Nice stems, short and stocky, dried well
- Solid, hefty fruit

Little Giant

- From Seedway
- 100 days to harvest
- 2 foot in row spacing
- Spacer variety





Miniwarts

- From Harris Seeds
- 110 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 2 lbs
- Stems are hard as nails
- Happy orange color
- Excellent for this size
- Very uniform shape and size
- Light heft

Naked Bear

- From Seedway
- 105 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 2.3 lbs
- Hulless seed variety
- Yellow skin
- Big, thick stems dried very hard
- Seeds are very tasty roasted







Orange Sunrise

- From Seedway/Harris Seeds
- 80 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 12.6 lbs
- Stems are okay
- Nice shallow, even ribbing
- Nice round shape
- Medium to dark orange color

Orion

- From Outstanding Seeds/Holmes Seed
- 90 days to harvest
- 6 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 17.6 lbs
- Nice stems, dried down well
- Interesting variation in shape and size
- Nice looking fruit





Pegasus

- From Outstanding Seed/Holmes Seed
- 95 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 13.1 lbs
- Stems dried down to rock hard, although they aren't big
- Very solid and dense fruit
- Medium orange to yellow orange color.
- Overall nice fruit

Racer Plus

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
- 85 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 9.7 lbs
- Stems are bad, brittle and whithered
- Good size and shape
- Orangey brown color





Renegade

- From Johnny's Selected Seeds
 - 120 days to harvest
- 3 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 10.5 lbs
- Stems are frayed and breaking
- Uniform in shape and size
- Nice medium to dark orange color

Rhea

- From Harris Seeds
- 110 days to harvest
- 7 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 15.6 lbs
- Some massive stems, a few doughy but overall good
- Good size and shape
- Medium to dark orange color
- Very nice fruit

- Heavy and dense for size
- Stems are good and sturdy
- Nice medium fruit

- Nice dark orange color
- Hefty fruit for its size

- Okay for specialty markets
- Orange/brown flecks in the skin

- Great stems, hard as rocks

- Held color very well in
 field, spent 3 weeks after
 windrowing outside
- Slight yellowing
 - Stems are okay, some thin
 - Smooth skin texture

Secretariat

- From Siegers Seed/Harris Seeds
- 105 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 11.9 lbs
- Excellent shape and ribbing with some variability
- Stems are good
- Light heft
- Very nice color
- Excellent fruit





Skidoo Gold

- From Rupp Seed
 Company
- 90 day to harvest
- 5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 10.1 lbs
- Medium to dark dark orange color
- Short and okay stems, some doughy
- Nice size and shape

Spark

- From Seedway
- 90 days to harvest
- 1.5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 0.4 lbs
- Munchkin type but very small
- Nice stems, sturdy
- Nice shape variation
- Good yield





Specter

- From Harris Seeds
- 95 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 11 lbs
- White variety that didn't hold color very well
- Stems aren't great, some fraying
- Has bumps and warts
- Unique and different but not sure on fit yet

Tallon

- From Harris Seeds
- 7 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 22.3 lbs
- Stems are fragile and doughy
- Lovely shape and ribbing
- Beautiful dark orange color with a little russeting
- Beautiful fruit other than stems





Thor

- From Siegers Seed
- 105 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 14.8 lbs
- Terrible stems, might be the worst of the whole trial
- Lovely dark orange color
- Has lumps that may be due to virus

Warty Gnome

- From Harris Seeds
- 95 days to maturity
- 5 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 2.5 lbs
- Space saucer shaped
- Stems are rock hard and nice
- Fairly uniform shape, size and color
- Nice for specialty market





Warty Goblin

- From Seedway/Harris Seeds
- 105 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight 12.7 lbs
- Larger, warted variety.
- Dark orange color with lighter/green warts
- Stems are dried well and hard
- Retail sales would be good but might be hard to pack
- Solid, dense fruit

Zeus

- From Seedway
- 110 days to harvest
- 4 foot in row spacing
- Average weight: 11.3 lbs
- Stems are withered and doughy
- Color goes from yellow/orange to dark orange
- Okay shape and size
