

- Mostly large A's with a few B's, not many chefs
- Heavily muted skin with some texture, some silver scurf
- Deep apical end eyes with some raised lenticels on other eyes.

- Disappointed in the variable color, some pink, some medium red but overall light

- Large size
- Issue with cracking due to harvesting when cold
- Medium to deep eyes
- Mostly oblong with smaller tubers being more rounded

- White skin with purple splash, yellow flesh
- Variable in shape, some oblongs, some rounds
- Culls are misshapes
- The purple splash around eyes is inconsistent, with maybe 30 to 40 percent have the purple
- Some silver scurf mutes the color even more
- Eyes are shallow to medium
- Deeper eyes have more purple color
- Nice dark yellow flesh, darker than Yukon Gold.
- A little skin texture, netting

- Fairly uniform

- Flattened oblong shape
- Internal issues, hollow heart and browning
- Some scab
- Lots of culls, knobs, misshapes and growth cracks

- Very few, shallow eyes with a few raised
- A few odd shapes
- Beautiful dark yellow skin
- Some texture due to silver scurf

- Yellow skin, nice yellow flesh
- High setting B type, lots of tubers
- Round to flat round, with a few oblongs
- A few tear shapes, some dumbbells
- A's are small
- Smooth skin with little blemishes
- Eyes are shallow and few

- A lot of misshapes, knobs, dumbbells
- Very shallow eyes with most raised, giving it a slightly lumpy look
- Beautiful skin with few blemishes
- Mostly oblong, long tubers with smaller being rounds
- Way too many misshapes to be completely culled out

- Can be a little lumpy, like Chieftan
- Good size
- Firm flesh
- Fairly uniform

- Bright purple skin, bright white flesh
- Looks really nice and is uniform
- Mostly oblong round with some flattened tubers
- Eyes are deep, especially on the apical end but few
- A little scab and silver scurf

- Blue skin, purple blue flesh
- Oblong with some knobs
- Fairly deep eyes with some raised lenticels
- Few B's
- Chefs are oblongs, A's are flat oblongs to round oblongs
- Flesh is purple blue with a flash of white on outside, very attractive
- Fair amount of silver scurf

Fleure Bleue

- Dark blue/purple skin, starburst medium dark purple with white ring
- Fingerling
- Long, thin shape with tapering at stem end
- Very shallow and small eyes
- Not very lumpy
- Culls are rattails and misshapes

US Blue

- Blue skin, with starburst blue flesh
- Fingerling
- Long, oblong round
- Big for a fingerling
- Lots of shallow eyes
- Some knobs and misshapes, bottlenecks
- Didn't run well through the grader, with some getting caught in the chains
- Muted blue skin with various issues
- Not the prettiest but a solid fingerling that will produce a decent amount of large tubers

Purple Majesty

- Dark blue skin, dark purple flesh
- Smaller than US Blue but prettier
- Medium to slightly deep eyes
- No blemishes
- Some misshapes like dumbbells and pointed ends
- Flesh stays purple after cooking
- Fewer bumps

- A lot of culls due to misshapes
- Some shallow, some raised eyes
- Some alligator hide
