








Trial Information


- Schoharie County on a Barbour loam

- Dryland plot
- Harvested October 11th and graded November 6th using grower grader with chains set at various lengths as seen in data



- Firm texture after cooking, mild to no flavor









- Very dry texture after cooking, taste is mild but nice








